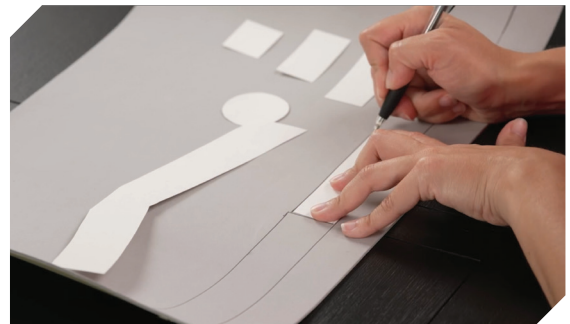
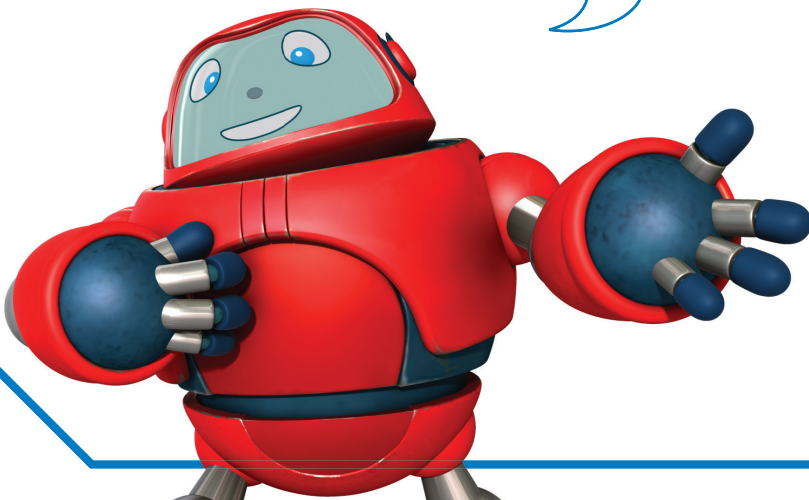
Scan the QR code on the right to make this exciting craft along with Miss Tina! You can also watch her in the episode. Don't forget to ask your big helper to assist you.

Enjoy this kid-friendly activity!

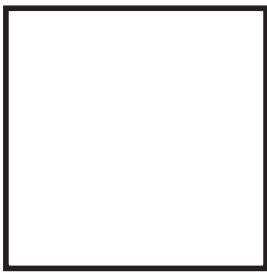
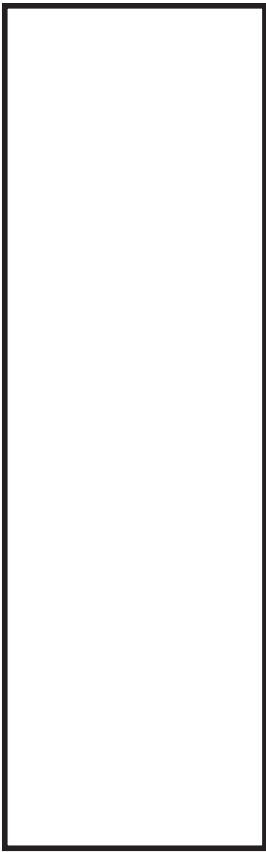
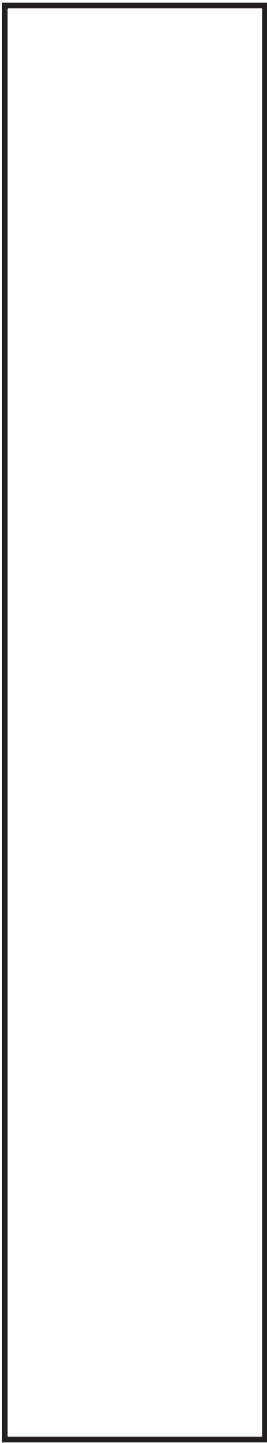
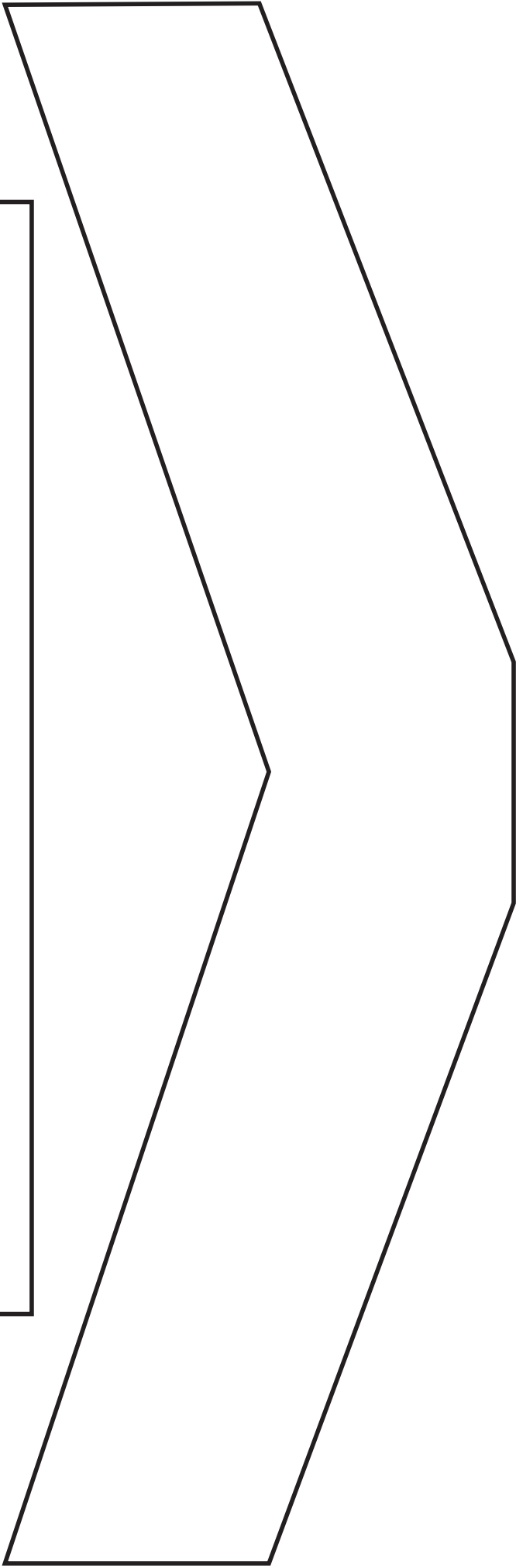

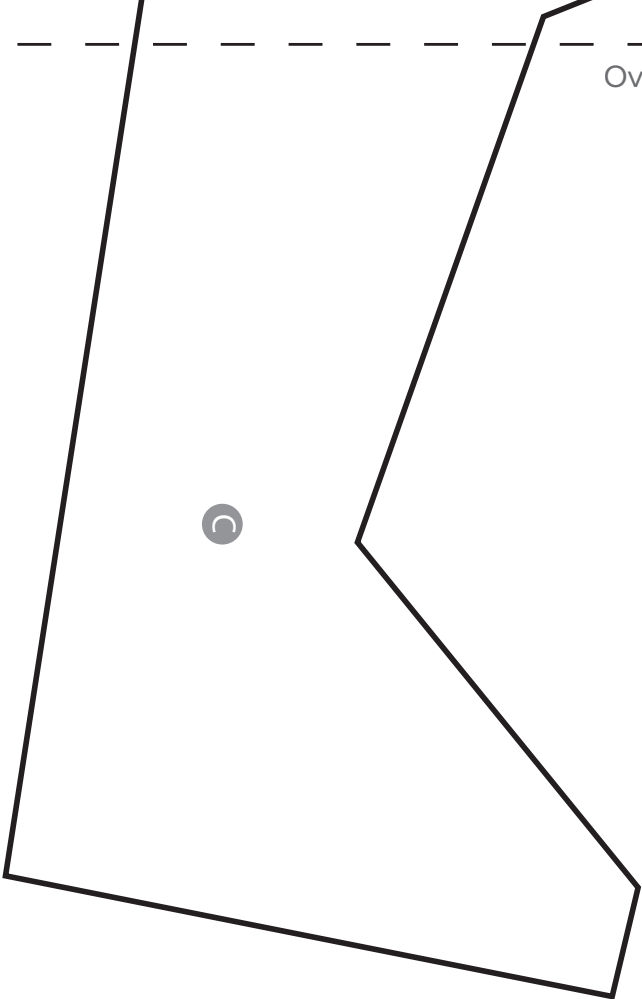

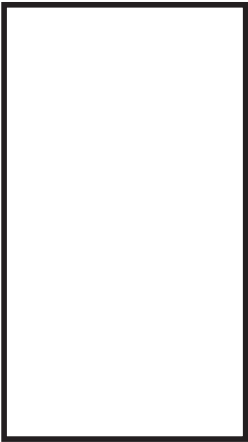
Overlap and tape B and C

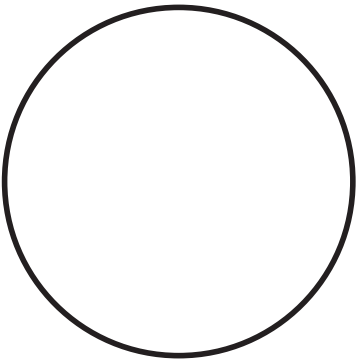
