His love for you is beyond measure and His commitment to care for you will never end. How wonderful to know that the all-powerful God of creation has given you His promise to protect and rescue you.

The dictionary defines the word *protect* as: to keep safe; to keep from harm; to shield; preserve; shelter; defend; to look after; to take care of; to guard from attack; to shield from danger, loss, or injury. And, when we look at the definition of the word *rescue*, we find: to save from a dangerous or distressing situation; to bring someone out of danger, attack or harm.
