SuperTruth:

 - Isaac submitted to the will of his father, allowing himself to be sacrificed. Jesus submitted to the will of God—his Father—allowing himself to be crucified.
 - God spared Isaac’s life and provided a ram to take his place. Jesus took our place by dying on the cross and paying for our sins.

- Saturday, December 20: Signposts to Jesus**
 - The angel Gabriel prophesied that John would grow up to prepare the way for Jesus, the Savior of the world.

- Sunday, December 21: Watch “The First Christmas”**
- Monday, December 22: Read Matthew 1:18-25
- Tuesday, December 23: Read Matthew 2:1-12
- Wednesday, December 24: Watch “The Promise of a Child”**
- Wednesday, December 24: Read Luke 2:1-7
- Thursday, December 25: Read Luke 2:8-20
- Friday, December 26: Read Isaiah 9:1-7
- Saturday, December 27: Signposts to Jesus**
 - The prophets told us the Savior would be born in Bethlehem, come out of Egypt, and be called a Nazarene. Those seem to contradict each other, but Jesus fulfilled all those prophecies.
 - God promised in the Garden of Eden, to send a Savior that would pay for our sins. Later, in Genesis, God promised the Savior would come from Abraham’s lineage through Isaac and Jacob and then David. Jesus is that Savior.

- Monday, December 29: Read Romans 15:1-6
- Tuesday, December 30: Read Romans 15:7-13
- Wednesday, December 31: Read Hebrews 13:8-14

- Saturday, January 3: Signposts to Jesus**

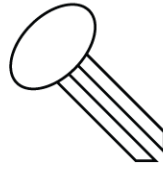


DECEMBER BIBLE READING PLAN Code Breaker

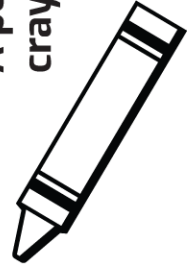
ITEMS NEEDED

for best results.



Brass Fastener
Can be substituted
with brad fasteners



Marker
A pen, pencil or
crayon works too.

Step 1

Print, cut out, and assemble the code breaker.

Step 2

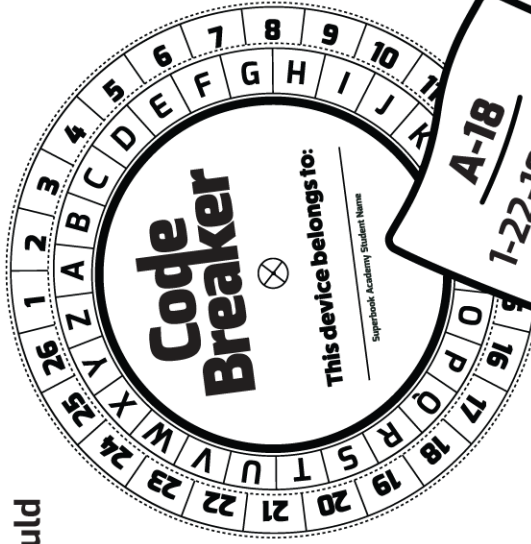
Turn the smaller wheel on the code breaker to set your code and mark down where the letter "A" lands. (For example, if the "A" is next to the number 18, then you would write down A-18.)

Step 3

Now if the code is set you can write a secret message using that code. Write down a number for each letter. For example, if you wanted to write J-E-S-U-S, with your code breaker set to A-18, you would write the numbers 1-22-10-12-10. See image to right.

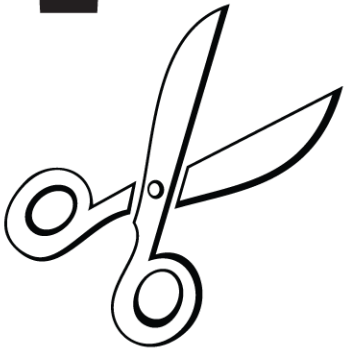
Step 4

Once you write your code, give it to a friend so that they can figure out your secret message using the code breaker.

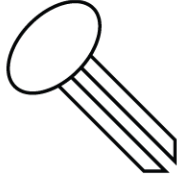

Cut along the dotted lines first. Place a brass fastener in the center and use it to connect the two circles. Make sure that the smaller circle is on top of the larger circle.

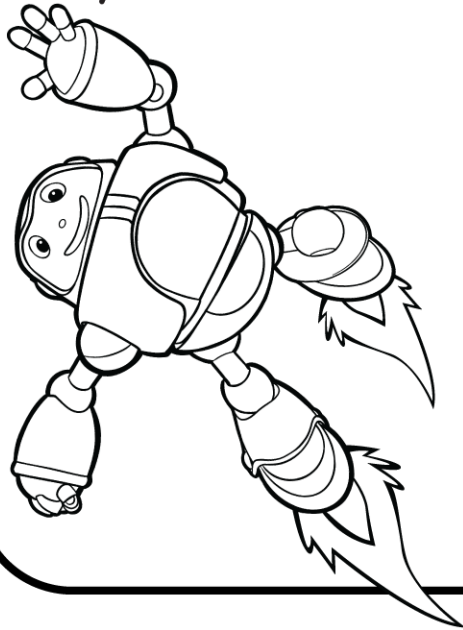
