BEHIND THE VERSES: THE BIBLE BACKGROUND

“Nicodemus” Bible Background:



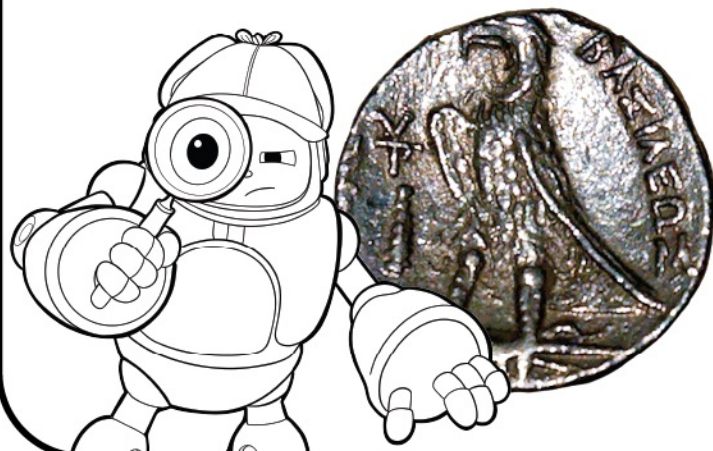
At the beginning of the episode, Jesus and Nicodemus are shown sitting together for a Sabbath meal. While the exact location of this meal is unknown, the room itself is traditionally referred to as a triclinium. A triclinium was a Roman-style dining room designed specifically for shared meals and gatherings. These rooms were often elaborately decorated, featuring richly colored mosaic floors and ornate designs that reflected their importance as places of hospitality and conversation.

While records in the ancient world were often kept on scrolls or even written on pieces of broken pottery, Zacchaeus is shown in the episode using a wax tablet to record tax information. The wax surface, contained within a wooden base, could be smoothed and reused, allowing new details to be written over old ones. This made wax tablets especially useful for calculations, such as determining how much tax a person owed. Displayed beside the tablet are several Roman styluses, like the tools Zacchaeus would have used to write and record his accounts.

After his triumphal entry into Jerusalem, Matthew 21 describes Jesus overturning the tables of the money changers and driving them out of the temple. In the Court of the Gentiles, merchants sold animals for sacrifice, and money changers exchanged foreign currency for the approved temple coins needed to make purchases. The image shows a Tyrian shekel, one of the coins accepted in Jerusalem at the time. Jesus was angered by the dishonest practices of the money changers, including excessive fees and exploitation, and he forcefully drove them out of the temple courts.

BEHIND THE VERSES: THE BIBLE BACKGROUND

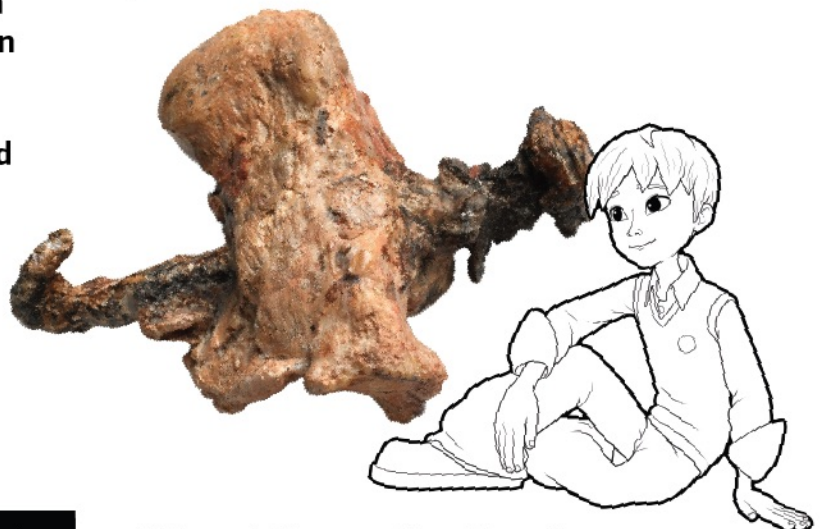
“Peter’s Denial” Bible Background:



By the time Peter began following Jesus, he had settled in Capernaum. Luke 4:38–39 recounts how Jesus left the synagogue there, went to Peter’s house (Peter is called Simon in Luke 4:38), and healed his mother-in-law. The image shown depicts a site archaeologists believed to be the ancient remains of Peter’s home. Evidence suggests that first-century Christians later visited this house, as short prayers to Jesus were etched into the walls in multiple languages, including Greek, Syriac, Hebrew, and Latin.

The act of crucifixion involved nailing a person’s wrists and ankles to a wooden cross and raising it upright, causing intense pain and agony. The image shown is the heel bone of a man named Yehohanan, who was also crucified, providing archaeological evidence of this brutal practice. The cruelty of crucifixion highlights the suffering Jesus endured—and, even more, the depth of God’s love in sending his Son to die for our sins.

Although the exact location of the Sermon on the Mount is unknown, scholars agree it took place near Capernaum and Tabgha. The hills in that area sloped gently towards the sea. The hills would naturally carry sound and could accommodate large crowds. About 400 years after Jesus’ time, a church was built in the area to commemorate his teaching and miracles.



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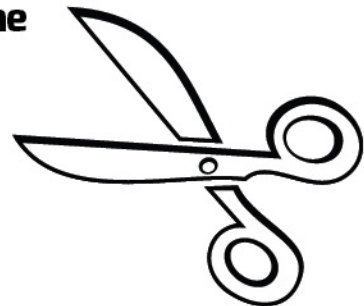
