Bible Reading Plan

SuperTruth:

When we follow Jesus, people should be able to see how we act and speak and know that we are his followers. We should also tell people about Jesus every chance we get. This is called being a good witness.

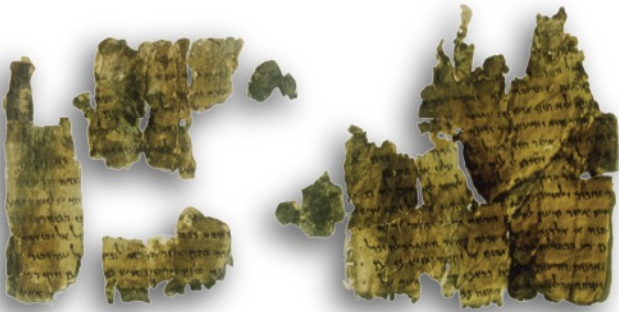

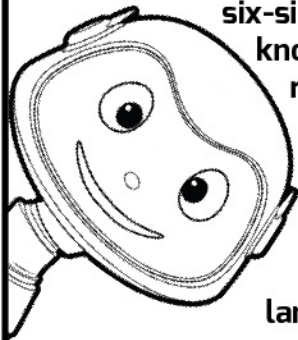
BEHIND THE VERSES: THE BIBLE BACKGROUND

“John the Baptist” Bible Background:



In the episode, John the Baptist offers the kids locusts and honey to eat. Though eating locusts—a type of grasshopper—may seem unusual today, they were considered clean under Jewish law and were a common food source in the desert. The Damascus Rule, an ancient scroll outlining the practices of a Jewish community living near John the Baptist, even lists locusts as part of their diet.

In this episode, the kids arrive during the Assyrian siege of Jerusalem led by King Sennacherib. Sennacherib ruled Assyria about 700 years before the time of Jesus. The



six-sided clay artifact shown, known as the Sennacherib Prism, records his campaign against King Hezekiah of Judah and the capture of 46 Judean cities. The inscription is written in Akkadian, one of the world's oldest written languages.

“Isaiah” Bible Background:



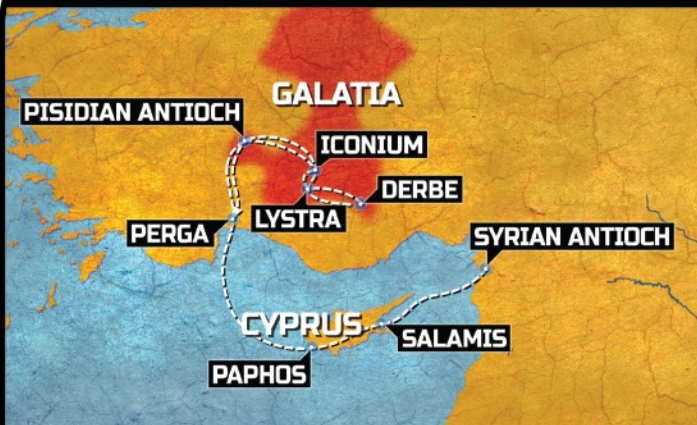
“Baptized!” Bible Background:



In this episode, the disciples are shown fishing on the Sea of Galilee, a central setting for many events in Jesus' ministry, including his calming of the storm. This freshwater lake, measuring about 13.5 miles long and 7.5 miles wide, was rich in fish such as tilapia, carp, and sardines. The image on the left shows a model of a fishing boat from Jesus' time; historians note that boats like these could carry up to 2,000 pounds. In the episode, the catch is so large that it nearly sinks two boats!

BEHIND THE VERSES: THE BIBLE BACKGROUND

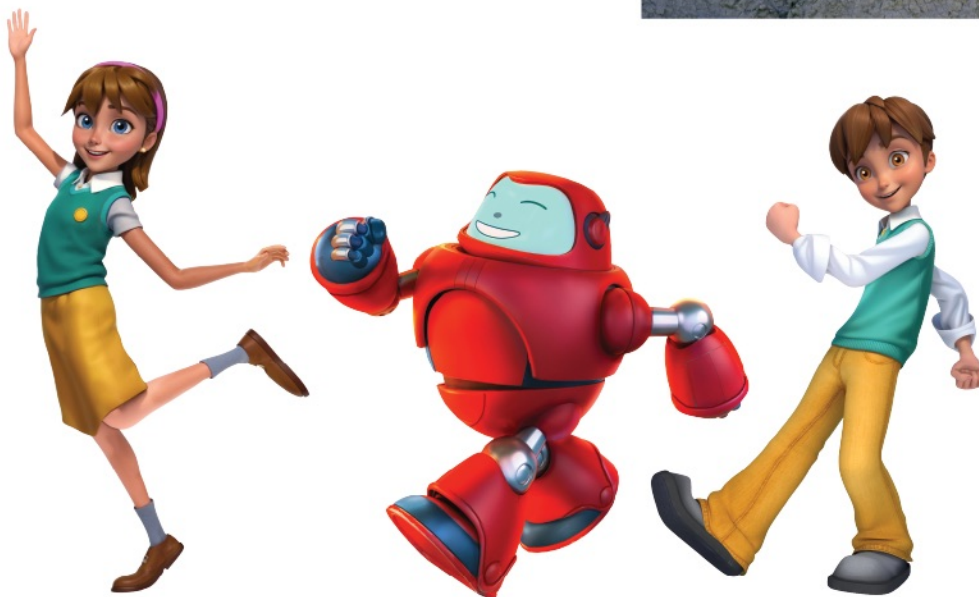
“Paul & Barnabas” Bible Background:



This map traces Paul and Barnabas's first missionary journey. To recap: they began in Syrian Antioch, where both served as leaders in the church, then traveled to Cyprus and met Sergius Paulus, the Roman proconsul. From there, they sailed to Perga in Asia Minor and journeyed inland to Pisidian Antioch, entering the region of Galatia and visiting cities such as Iconium, Lystra, and Derbe. Despite opposition in some of these places, Paul and Barnabas revisited the cities on their return journey. They were more invested in sharing the Gospel than on their own safety!

The Tower of Babel was built on the Plain of Shinar in ancient southern Mesopotamia. Because of its location, the tower was likely a ziggurat—a Mesopotamian structure with a square base and sloping sides that rise in stepped terraces, resembling a pyramid. Archaeologists have uncovered the remains of more than 30 ziggurats across the region. The oldest, found in the ancient Sumerian city of Eridu, is over 7,000 years old!
