The LORD gives his people strength.

Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything.

Don't Worry!

out your heart to Him and tell Him your need. He won't resent you asking, no matter how great or small the miracle is that you need. His heart and His throne room are always open to you.

Thank Him for What He Has Done

Here is an important key to answered prayer. Thank God for His answer even before it arrives. God has been at work before the foundation of the world, creating a way of salvation for you. The Bible tells us that before we even call on Him—He is at work on our behalf. Let your eyes of faith thank Him for the solution to your problem and answer to your request.
